## A School Where All Kids Belong!

*An Olweus Bullying Prevention Model School*

1. Establishing a coordinating committee to address the implementation and coordination of the bullying prevention program initiatives
2. Assessing bullying by surveying students in 3<sup>rd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades
3. Kick-Off-support from the entire school community
4. Increase adult supervision by addressing hotspots
5. School/classroom rules about bullying
6. Sanctions/enforcement of school rules and policies
7. Weekly classroom meetings
8. Monthly teacher discussion groups
9. Quarterly parent discussion circles
10. Meeting with parents of students who bully and who are bullied
11. Staff readings on bullying prevention to support the initiative
12. Establishing buy-in by training and in servicing staff

### Others:

- a. Focusing on school climate and social norms.
- b. Intervening consistently and appropriately in bullying incidences.
- c. Continuing efforts over time by weaving into fabric of school
